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ROMANCING THE PAST: LUPERCALIA'S SHADOW ON VALENTINE'S DAY

Lupercalia was an ancient Roman festival that took place annually on February 15. It was a pagan celebration with roots dating back to the founding of Rome. The festival was dedicated to Lupercus, the Roman god of fertility, as well as to the founders of Rome, Romulus and Remus. Lupercalia was known for its unconventional and sometimes dark rituals, and its eventual replacement by Valentine's Day is a fascinating historical transition.

Origins of Lupercalia

The origins of Lupercalia can be traced back to the pre-Roman pastoral societies. It was initially associated with the Roman shepherd, who would lead a group of priests known as the Luperci in rituals to purify the city and promote fertility. The Luperci, dressed in goat skins, would run through the streets, striking people with thongs made from sacrificed goats, believed to bring fertility and ward off evil spirits.

Dark Rituals of Lupercalia

One of the central rituals of Lupercalia involved the Luperci sacrificing goats and a dog at the Lupercal, the cave where, according to Roman mythology, Romulus and Remus were nursed by a she-wolf. The blood from the sacrificed animals was then smeared on the foreheads of two young priests, who would laugh and wipe off the blood with wool soaked in milk.

Following this, the Luperci would



cut the sacrificed hides into strips, fashioning thongs called "februa." These thongs were then used in a unique purification ritual where the priests, both young and old, would run naked or nearly naked through the streets, striking those they encountered. It was believed that being touched by the februa would ensure fertility and ward off infertility and evil.

The Controversial Nature of Lupercalia

While Lupercalia had deep cultural and religious significance for the

ancient Romans, its rituals were considered by many as crude and even barbaric. The festival's association with fertility and purification through unconventional means led to criticisms from various quarters.

The raucous behavior of the Luperci and the bizarre rituals involving animal sacrifice and nudity drew the ire of some Roman authorities and intellectuals. The festival became increasingly controversial as Rome evolved, and attitudes towards religious practices and cultural traditions shifted.

The Transition to Valentine's Day

The decline of Lupercalia was gradual, and several factors contributed to its eventual replacement by Valentine's Day. One of the key influencers was the rise of Christianity in the Roman Empire. As Christianity gained prominence, pagan festivals like Lupercalia were viewed with skepticism and disapproval.

executed on February 14.

The romantic connotations of Valentine's Day provided a stark contrast to the fertility-focused rituals of Lupercalia, making it more palatable for evolving societal norms.

Banning of Lupercalia

While there isn't a specific historical record of an official ban on Lupercalia, the festival waned in significance over the centuries. The Christian authorities' efforts to replace it with a more acceptable celebration contributed to its decline. By the end of the 5th century, Lupercalia had largely disappeared

from Roman society, replaced by the emerging traditions associated with Valentine's Day.

Lupercalia, with its dark and unconventional rituals, was an integral part of ancient Roman culture. However, as societal norms evolved and Christianity gained prominence, the festival faced criticism and eventual decline. The transition to Valentine's Day marked a shift from a pagan fertility celebration to a more socially acceptable day of expressing love and affection. Understanding the historical context of Lupercalia provides valuable insights into the complex interplay between religious, cultural, and societal forces that shape the traditions we observe today.



KITCHEN WITCH'S CAULDRON

Ingredients

15 fresh bay leaves
3 eggs
8 ounces ricotta cheese
1/2 cup honey
1 teaspoon grated orange zest
1 teaspoon lemon juice
1/2 cup all-purpose flour

SAVILLUM (ANCIENT ROMAN CHEESECAKES)



Instructions

Preheat an oven to 425 degrees F (220 degrees C).

Pour some water into a small, oven proof bowl, and place into the oven.

Arrange the bay leaves over the bottom of the greased springform pan to cover.

Beat the eggs in a mixing bowl, then mix in ricotta cheese, honey, orange zest, and lemon juice.

Sprinkle in the flour, and stir until evenly combined.

Gently pour the batter over the bay leaves, being careful not to disturb them too much.

Bake in the preheated oven until browned, about 35 to 40 minutes. Run the tip of a paring knife around the edges of the pan, and release from the springform pan. Invert onto a serving plate, and serve warm or chilled.



Feast and Sharing:


