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# The Triple Goddess Mindset



Witches do not deal in binaries. We look to the spiritual, beyond the physical and emotional. We trust intuition which some consider the middle ground of evidence and suspicion. Witches know that the universe is more complicated than good vs. evil: we work magic in the gray areas. It is not man vs. nature: it is humanity, nature, and Spirit. We respect the liminal, and meditate at the crossroads. Triplicity is our mindset, not duality, and it is exemplified perfectly in the Triple Goddess.

The Triple Goddess is the Maiden, Mother, and Crone. As a deity, she has been revered for thousands of years, dating back to Proto-Indo European religions. She is not limited to biological feminine experience: she is a manifestation of the mindset of witches. A mindset that embraces the in between whether at the margins of society or revolutionary and standing out. The Triple Deity guides from three aspects, rather than two, showing that a dualistic, hierarchical, linear thinking does not serve many.

Dualistic thinking is always tied to hierarchy. It generates competition. It necessitates choice, pointing to a single correct answer. Binaries imply a superiority on one side. It's never good and evil, it's good vs. evil, leaving no room for the subjectivity of justice. Man vs. Woman leaves no room for those who are nonbinary, Two-Spirit, Bakla, or transgender people. The dualistic thinking of patriarchy tells us it is us vs. them. It rejects the possibility of middle ground and gray areas, and by extension, discussion.

Many witches prefer the middle ground, the liminal, the crossroads. The Triple Goddess embraces aspects of the three: the past, present and future, fun, necessary, and difficult, experience, knowledge, and wisdom. When one rejects duality, potential is expanded because we accept that there is no failure or success, but the lesson of the process that lies along the journey. By embracing



the Triple Goddess approach to life, we open ourselves to more opportunities by accepting its not just extrinsic or intrinsic, but the self, society, and Spirit that determines what comes our way.

The Triple Goddess also rejects linear thinking. To think linearly is to assume that the further in time we go, the more progress we achieve. Linear thinking believes that the past is less informed, and therefore less perfect. This is true in simple ways: plumbing, hygiene, electricity,

decision making,

globalization, and travel are all definitely progressive from early days. Things like lamps and toilets, airplanes and Instagram aren't what make us human. Humans made those things. When we look at mankind's depths, what truly encompasses us is empathy. Not to mention our drive for: thinking and memory, creativity and art, written language, community, awareness of self, contemplation of spirit, and reverence for the universe. Lessons of allowing others to

believe how they want, worship how they may, offer things to a god or many gods: these are what makes one human.

The Triple Goddess asks us to remember that time is a construct and we go through all the phases of youth, parent, and revered elder. We are often all three at any given time in our lives. We are the nurturer to children, patients, or customers, but the child in some relationships, or the elder in others. The child is as close to Spirit as the elder, recently brought into life as the latter will soon pass into death. Therein lies wisdom to possess. The parent is influential in the growth of the child, and care of the elder. We are only here because of changes, choices, empathy (or lack thereof) from those who came before. They are still here, in the institutions, inventions, and resources we have and do not have today. The only thing that can save us from the same mistakes is to study them, to call them, and to remember. To embrace humanity, through creativity, community, and selfawareness, we must be guided by the Triple Deity's reminder to cycle.

Instead of love or loneliness: Loving/beloved/loveless

Instead of male or female: woman/nonbinary/man

> Instead of good or evil: Black/gray/white

Instead of thought or action: Body/mind/spirit

Instead of inaction and action: suspicion/observance/intuition

> Instead of life and death: birth/growth/wisdom

As we embrace the Triple Goddess mindset, we will be brought to an expansion of being present in the moment and ready in the next. We view time in a different way and enrich our existence through change, progress, and the cycle of youth, parent, and elder. 
There are numerous dangers everywhere. We do not suggest everyone lives in fear, but without protection in the powerful equation, many worse things can be brought into the

# **Hestia:** The Greek Goddess of Hearth, Home and Architecture

# Who is Hestia?

Hestia is a goddess from Ancient Greece that is largely overlooked, in favor of other more popular and well-known goddesses. Although is widely worshiped she is neglected in the pantheon.

Hestia was the eldest child of Cronus and Rhea, and was subsequently swallowed by her father. Hestia was the first born, and the first to be swallowed. Demeter, Poseidon, Hades and Hera all followed Hestia. When Zeus forced his father to regurgitate his children: Hestia was the last to be expelled, leading her to be both the oldest and youngest child.

Hestia was the goddess of the Hearth, Home, Architecture, Domesticity, the Family and the State. She was one of the three virgin goddesses along with Artemis and Athena. Poseidon and Apollo wished to court her though she made a vow to Zeus that she would remain pure and untouched by a man. Zeus agreed and she became off limits to all.

# Venerating Hestia?

Although she was the most widely worshiped goddess in Ancient Greece, she did not have any temples dedicated to her. Because she was the Goddess of the Hearth, she was personified as a fire burning in every hearth of the homes around Greece. Hestia would receive the first offering at every sacrifice in the home. Families would put sweet wine in her name and dedicate the best and richest food for her.

The fire in the hearth of each

home was not allowed to go out, unless it was ritually extinguished. Even though she didn't have a cult or temple she was worshiped at any temple; regardless of who it was dedicated to. Some towns would have an outdoor fire burning in their communities that were dedicated to Hestia, for the community as a whole, not an individual home or

family. When new towns were founded, one of the public fires would be taken to bless the new town in honor of Hestia. When a child was born, they would be welcomed into the family/ community by presenting the child to Hestia's Hearth

# What was Hestia like?

Hestia was said to be the gentlest of the Olympian family of gods, she was kind, forgiving, passive and non-confrontational. Many think of her as bland, colorless and flavorless because there is not much written about her character. Hestia was a virgin goddess; she never had any offspring, though many believed she would have made a great mother.

### Hestia and I

As a Pantheist, I tend to venerate and worship the divine in broader aspects like Divine Masculine and Divine Feminine and the pantheons of deities are facets of each greater force, that being said in my home I have special altars and places for two goddesses. Bastet (I have cats that have transitioned and are alive) and Hestia. I think she has always had a place in my home, and I have always thanked her for the roof, warmth and joy that has filled my home. I have recently started gathering things that are sacred to Hestia to create an altar in the kitchen, as that has always been seen as the heart of the home especially in antiquity when the hearth fire was the center of the home.

One of the most prominent things I ask Hestia for is protection of my Hearth and Home with the sacred fire. In the past I have even asked her to reinforce my own personal boundaries in complicated relationships at work and personally. For me, Hestia is that feeling when you get home after a long hard day and you just sink into the comfort of the sounds and smells of home.


a seven-star cluster in the Taurus constellation called the Pleiades. It is believed that healers' and lightworkers' souls originated there. These people are known as Starseeds.



# **Full Harvest Moon in September**

Moon reaches its peak in the morning hours of September 10, 2022. Learn how the Harvest Moon got its name—plus, see Moon phase dates, Best Days by the Moon, folklore, and more!

### When to See the Full Moon in September 2022

year, look September's full Harvest Moon to rise just after sunset on Friday, September 9. It then reaches peak illumination at 5:58 A.M. Eastern Time on Saturday the 10th, drifting below the horizon shortly thereafter.

### Why Is It Called the Harvest Moon?

The full Moon names used by The Old Farmer's Almanac come from a number of places, including Native American, Colonial American, and European sources. Traditionally, each full Moon name was applied to the entire lunar month in which it occurred and through all of the Moon's phases—not only the full Moon. The Harvest Moon,

September's full Harvest however, is a bit different!

The full Moon that happens nearest to the fall equinox (September 22 or 23) always takes on the name "Harvest Moon." Unlike other full Moons, this full Moon rises at nearly the same timearound sunset—for several evenings in a row, giving farmers several extra evenings of moonlight and allowing them to finish their harvests before the frosts of fall arrive.

While September's full Moon is usually known as the Harvest Moon, if October's full Moon happens to occur closer to the equinox than September's, it takes on the name "Harvest Moon" instead. In this case, September's full Moon is referred to as the Corn Moon.

### The Corn Moon

This time of year—late summer into early fall corresponds with the time of harvesting corn in much of the northern United States. For this reason, a number of Native American peoples traditionally used variation of the name "Corn Moon" to refer to the Moon of either August or September.

Moon (Western Abenaki) and Corn Harvest Moon (Dakota).

### Alternative September **Moon Names**

Other Moon names for this month highlight how September is the transitional period between summer and fall: Autumn Moon (Cree), Falling Leaves Moon (Ojibwe), Leaves Turning (Anishinaabe), Moon of Brown

Examples include Corn Maker Leaves (Lakota), Yellow Leaf Moon (Assiniboine).

> The behavior of animals is also a common theme, with Child Moon (Tlingit) referring to the time when young animals are weaned, and Mating Moon and Rutting Moon (both Cree) describing the time of year when certain animals, like moose, elk, and deer, are looking to mate.

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# Sacred Trees from Around the World

Trees are sacred to cultures all over the world, and many have featured in myths, legends, or fables throughout history. Some of the trees below you will have heard of, while others will be more obscure. Today I am going to take you on a journey around the world to look at the different sacred trees important to cultures all over the world.



# The Banyan Tree

This tree is believed to be the resting place of Krishna in Hinduism.

### The Bodhi Tree

This is the tree where Siddhartha Gautama attained enlightenment, afterwards becoming known as the Buddha.

# Donar's Oak

This tree is also known as Thor's Oak. The tree was felled by Saint Boniface and his retinue to build a church; they wanted

it to be on previously sacred ground.

### The Tree of Life

This is one of the trees in the Garden of Eden in Christian Mythology.

# The Tree of Knowledge (of good and evil)

This is another of the trees in the tales of the Garden of Eden. The eating of the fruit from this tree represents the beginning of the melding of good and evil – before they were separated.

### Laeroar

This is a tree that is often associated with Yggdrasil in Norse mythology.

# The Sacred Tree of Uppsala

This is a sacred tree that was located at the Temple of Uppsala in Sweden in the 11th Century. The only thing that is really known about the tree is that it was believed to have green leaves all year.

# **Yggdrasil**

This is possibly the most famous of the sacred trees. Yggdrasil is an immense mythical tree that plays a central role in Norse mythology as it connected all of the nine worlds.

# Akshayavat

This a sacred tree in Hinduism, where according to mythology the sage Markandeya asked Lord Narayana to show him a piece of divine power. For one moment, he flooded the world, and only Akshayavat could be seen above the water.

### Kadamba

This is a tree that is associated with the god Krishna (in Northern India) and Parvati Radha and Krishna (in Southern India). It is believed that they conducted their love play in the shade of the Kadamba tree.

### Sidrat-al-Muntaha

This is an enormous tree that marks the end of the seventh heaves, a boundary where no creation can pass. According to Islamic belief, during the Isra and Miraj, Muhammed – the only being who could pass – traveled with the archangel Gabriel to the tree, where the angel stopped walking and beyond this, it is said that God assigned the five daily prayers.

# **Datun Sahib**

This is the name of the tree in the main bazaar at Leh Ladakh in India. Guru Nanak visited the site of this tree around 1516. There is no Gurudwara at the site, but there are the remains of a large Meswak tree.

# **Cypress of Kashmar**

This is a sacred tree to the followers of Zoroastrianism. According to the Iranian Shahnameh, the tree grew from a branch that Zoroaster carried away from Paradise. He planted this branch in honor of King Vishtaspa to Zoroastrianism.

# **Fiscus Ruminalis**

This is a wild Fig tree that had both religious, historical, and legendary significance to the city of Rome. It stood near the small cave known as Lupercal, which according to legend was the cradle of Romulus and Remus, where they were nurtured by a she-wolf and discovered by Faustulus. The tree is sacred to Rumina, a deity associated with birth and childhood.

# Houisugi at Nakagawa

This is a 2000 year old Cedar tree that is revered by the Japanese locals because it is said to have prevented a great fire from spreading, and the evidence of this fire can still be seen on the tree.

# **Ocotea Faetens**

This is an evergreen tree that is sacred to the older inhabitants of El Hierro in the Canary Islands. It is sacred because it allowed the Bimbaches to thrive due to it supplying them with suitable amounts of water, a vital source of life.

# The Holy Thorn

This is a Hawthorn can be found in Glastonbury, England and is usual because unlike traditional Hawthorns, this one blooms twice a year. It blooms once in the winter around Christmas and again in the Spring around Easter. This tree is known as the Holy Thorn because of the legend of Joseph of Arimathea arriving in England. According to legend, Joseph of Arimathea thrust his staff into the ground of Wearyall Hill, which grew into the original tree. The original tree was destroyed with fire during the English Civil Warm however it was replaced with another tree in the 1950's. Each year a sprig of the Holy Thorn is sent to the Queen (of England) for her Christmas table.

### **Zapis**


This is a tree in Serbia that is sacred to those who live in its shadow. Crosses were carven into the trunk – it is usually a large Oak. In areas where there was no church, celebrations and festivals were held beneath its branches.

# The Tree of Immortality

This is a tree of life motif that features in the Quran, which says that it was the only tree in the Garden of Eden – there is no Tree of Knowledge in Islam. The Tree of Immortality would not decay and Allah forbade Adam

and Eve for touching the fruits it bore. As in the traditional story of the Garden of Eden, Satan appeared and told Adam and Eve that the only reason Allah told them not to eat the fruit, is because they would become angels.

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
# Merry Meet to Alana K. Haase


"Webs" is getting a new format this year! It's going to be available as an audio book very soon.
